


The Los Angeles Athletic Club features marquee retail space at 7th and Olive Streets, arguably one of Downtown's hottest corners.

This historic 1912 building has recently undergone a multimillion dollar renovation, and when complete, will feature a brand new storefront on the ground floor to compliement the unique beaux-arts style architecture of the building. 7th Street has historically been known as one of Downtown's premier retail streets, and users such as Bottega Louie, Uniqlo, Alamo Drafthouse Cinema, and PK Market are helping usher in the next phase.

Highlights:

- > Prime corner retail space on 7Th Street
- \Rightarrow ± 7,470 SF of retail space on the corner of 7th & Olive (divisible), plus an additional ± 4,335 SF space available facing 7th Street
- > New storefront will be installed (estimated July 2020)
- Across from the Nomad Hotel and the upcoming PK Market, and 1 block from Bottega Louie
- > Building built in 1912, and houses an 81-room boutique hotel.






Retail Site Plan



Los Angeles Athletic Club History



The Los Angeles Athletic Club has been operating out of its building at the corner of 7th and Olive Streets in DTLA since 1912.

Designed by renowned LA architects John Parkinson and George Bergstrom, The Beaux-Arts style structure was the first on the West Coast to have a pool (nicknamed "The Plunge") above the ground floor. From its outset, the Club was far more than a gym; it was a place where men and women came together to celebrate theatrics, poetry, and the ethos of sound mind in a sound body.











